Data Service: Changes in MARC 21 format for holdings data of the German Union Catalogue of Serials (ZDB) from week 03, 2014

Dear Sir or Madam

This is to inform you of the upcoming changes in MARC 21 format for holdings data of the German Union Catalogue of Serials (ZDB) from week 03, 2014 (13 - 17 January 2014):

MARC field 007 (Physical description fixed field - Microform) at position 11 (Generation)

The following two changes have been made in MARC field 007 for microforms regarding position 11 (Generation):

- The previous default value "z" is replaced by the default value "u" (unknown).
- The conditions for the issue of value "a" (first generation master) have been specified in more detail.

MARC field 856 (Electronic location and access), indicator 1 (Access method)

The default value for indicator 1 (Access method) has been changed in MARC field 856. Up to now a blank"_" has been issued as the default, whereas the next release will contain "4" (HTTP) as the default value.
