# Integrated Authority File (GND) Data Service: Changes in the MARC 21 format for authority data from 17 January 2017 (Export Release 2017.01)

Dear Sir or Madam

We would like to draw your attention to the Export Release 2017.01 of the MARC 21 format for authority data.

## 1. Schedule

The changes apply from:

- | 17 January 2017  
(There may be disruptions to the interfaces and the Data Shop between 08:00 and 12:00 noon during the technical changeover.)
- | Delivery 03, 2017 of the GND change service<sup>1</sup>

## 2. Format changes

### 2.1. In the future, various MARC fields will also contain the subfields \$h (Medium) (NR) and \$l (Language of a work) (NR)

As part of the introduction of RDA<sup>2</sup> cataloguing, the Work-Cataloguing code group and the Authority Data expert group have decided that it should be possible to capture authority records of the 'works' entity of the Integrated Authority File (GND) which include both work and expression attributes, where these records are required for subject cataloguing.

Such records are marked by the entity code<sup>3</sup> "wie" in MARC field 079 \$a. The relation code "dats" in MARC field 548 then stands both for "date of the work" and for "date of expression".

However, the above MARC subfields need to be introduced to represent the core elements<sup>4</sup> for expressions in the GND. The corresponding GND entry aid<sup>5</sup> for expressions is being developed.

Subfields:

- | \$h – Medium (NR)
- | \$l - Language of a work (NR):  
Preferred GND language designation<sup>6</sup>

The new subfields are being introduced for the following MARC fields:

- | 100, 110, 111, 130
- | 400, 410, 411, 430
- | 500, 510, 511, 530
- | 730

To avoid duplication, the new subfields \$h and \$l for MARC field 130 are uniquely documented. The notice "Weitere Unterfelder wie MARC-Feld 130" indicates this situation in the other fields.

## 2.2. Delivery of MARC field 336 (Content type) (R) with subfield \$a (Content type term) (R)

For the same reason as described in paragraph 2.1, subfield \$a (Content type term) is also being introduced in order to convey information on expressions. The previously unused source field in the GND data is scheduled to be released for entries from 17 January 2017, resulting in field 336 being delivered in the following form for the first time.

The equivalent use of MARC field 339 (Media type / Carrier type) (R) has already been prepared, but will not be used initially.

## 2.3. Omission of the prefix "(uri)" in the subfields \$0

As a result of a decision<sup>7</sup> taken by the MARC Advisory Committee regarding the URIs in the \$0 subfields, the prefix "(uri)" will now be omitted. The decision is based on a discussion paper<sup>8</sup> entitled "Redefining Subfield \$0 to Remove the Use of Parenthetical Prefix '(uri)' in the MARC 21 Authority, Bibliographic, and Holdings Formats" which was presented by the PCC Task Group on URIs<sup>9</sup> in MARC.

The following MARC fields are affected by this change in the GND:

034, 260, 372, 380, 382, 500, 510, 511, 530, 550, 551, 682, 700, 710, 711, 730, 750 and 751

## 2.4. Further notes

In MARC field 260 (Complex See Reference – Subject), delivery of the comments in the \$v field was incorrect. The concordance for the MARC export has been revised, and the content is now delivered as documented.

## 4. Unconfirmed advance information about the next but one release

The information on the 2017.02 or 2017.03 releases is only provisional, as changes are being made to the DNB conversion service. For this reason, advance information on the planned format modification for release 2017.02 is unfortunately not possible.

If release 2017.02 is dispensed with, advance information on the 2017.03 release will be published during the course of February 2017.

Planning status:

The GND-related decisions of the MARC Advisory Committee meeting<sup>10</sup> held in June 2016 are expected to be implemented in export-release 2017.03 (September). This release will also contain the changes laid down by the Expert group authority data<sup>11</sup> regarding biographic information in MARC field 672 (previously MARC 692) and biographic/historical information (MARC field 678 \$a/\$b).
